Mr Callum McBryde- Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeon **Celebrity Hips**

Mr McBryde qualified at Birmingham University where he was awarded the esteemed RH Sage award for best surgical trainee of the year. Through his work with the Birmingham hip resurfacing he was awarded the first ever large research bursary from the British Hip Society. This led to a number of landmark research papers, national prizes and the award of a higher degree from the University of Birmingham. He completed his fellowship with one of the world leaders in hip surgery in young patients in Sydney. In 2010 Mr McBryde was successfully awarded the prestigious European Travelling fellowship by the British Hip Society.
